

Deaf Bull Terrier For Sale at Dallas Pet Store

KNOW YOUR BREEDER

Over the past month *Bully Times* had been getting reports of a young Bull Terrier for sale in a local pet store. Thanks to a Volunteer we have some information on the dog and this accompanying photo.

“So, I finally got a chance to stop by the store in Dallas and she was still there. As you can see she’s all white, and she’s deaf. She was so cute and beautiful. I was told she was purchased from the breeder for \$1699, but is on sale now for \$588. Is that a ridiculous price for a deaf dog of any kind?



Store personnel would not release any breeder info to me, but I was told this dog was bred by the same breeder that provides Bull Terriers for their other store in Lewisville. If that wasn’t disturbing enough, and the fact this dog is being sold intact, the person I spoke with told me she remembered my dog Turkish, who was purchased by his original owners from this same store, for \$2400. (*Editor’s note: Turk, who died from premature kidney failure, was profiled in a previous Bully Times, Know Your Breeder installment.*)

A lot of those memories came back to me and it seems all the more important now that I find out about and share the information on Turkish’s breeder and parents.”
